A New Strategy to Configure Generation Z Nurses

I am indeed very happy to be a part of the team in implementing the revised B.Sc. Nursing Curriculum, which embraces competency-based and outcome-based approach throughout the program by integrating the essence of mastery in learning and self-directed learning. The new system is a credit-based system, which focuses on inculcating ten core competencies within students that include patient centered care, professionalism, teaching and leadership, system based practice, health informatics and technology, communication, team work and collaboration, safety, quality improvement and evidence-based practice. The pivotal change in syllabus is that it is a semester-based curriculum with eight semesters in which the last semester is exclusively for internship with intensive practicum in all five specialties. It includes mandatory and elective modules, which help foster the standards in nursing care and assure the quality of care rendered by nurses as well. Nursing Education has taken a great leap by introducing three new subjects - Health Informatics & Technology, Professionalism and Forensic Nursing. I strongly believe that the revised syllabus will unquestionably mould nurses who will cater to the needs of Generation Z.






